
Online Privacy

PrimeSource Credit Union is committed to protecting the privacy of our members. In general, you can visit us on the World Wide Web without disclosing to us who you are or revealing any information about yourself. There are several areas, however, that will collect certain information about you and we want you to know how we handle that information.

If you visit our website, PrimeSource Credit Union collects and stores information on the domain you use to access our website, the Internet address of the site from which you linked directly to the site, and the date and time of your visit. This information is used to measure the number of visitors to the various pages on our site to better serve our membership.

If you send an email, PrimeSource Credit Union collects and stores personally-identifying information in order to process your e-mail, form or application. This information is not sold to any third parties. Due to the volume of e-mail activity, these messages are deleted after they are answered or completed.

If you visit a secure site, such as home banking, you will be asked for personal identification numbers which will give you access to the member only section of our website. This information enables PrimeSource Credit Union to regulate entry to the member only portions of our website and to measure member usage. Any identifying information gathered is not sold to third parties.

If you link to another site from any of our pages, you are leaving our site pages, and we cannot be held responsible for any information that may be gathered at a linked site. We make every effort however, to ensure that all linked sites follow similar privacy policies as ours to offer you maximum security and privacy.

Children's Privacy Protection Act

We are committed to protecting the online privacy of children. In accordance with the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act, we will not knowingly collect any personally identifiable information from children under the age of 13 without first obtaining parental consent. If we receive online information from any child we will only use the information to respond directly to the child's request. We recognize that protecting children's identities and online privacy is important and that responsibility rests with us and with parents. If you believe your child has provided personally identifiable information to use, please contact us so we can allow you the opportunity to review and delete such information.

Use of Internet Cookies

By using or accessing our site you are consenting to the Credit Union's use of Internet Cookies. "Cookies" are text-only pieces of information that a web site transfers to an individual's website browser. Like most web sites, we use cookies for purposes such as for analyzing website traffic to improve our site's performance, and for marketing so we can serve visitors relevant promotional ads on other sites they visit across the Internet. We use "performance cookies" to track visitors to our Website, which is done on an anonymous aggregate basis (as cookies do not in themselves carry any personal data). We may also employ cookies so that we remember your computer when it is used to return to the Website for analyzing traffic and marketing effectiveness.
